Technical / Engineering Assistance included: shared services, a RRVCSA Technician position with six other SWCDs.

Improved and more efficient technical/engineering assistance was provided to landowners in Red Lake County, by the hiring of a new District Technician.

The Arc GIS mapping for the County was improved dramatically by developing an updated County Drainage Ditch Map, creation of multiple Buffer Law Program maps, development BWSR Clean Water Fund and MDM grant individual landowner project maps, watershed area maps, etc.

District staff, Red Lake County Highway Dept. Engineer. and the Red Lake County Ditch Authority provided technical and engineering assistance to landowners.

District staff continued to collect information and data regarding to future erosion sites for the District's Erosion Site Inventory.

District staff assisted landowners who had questions about their property and how it relates to the Buffer Law Program and assisted landowners with other District implemented program related questions.

District staff updated and continues to update the districts' filing system for past, existing, and future projects.

District staff conducted site visits as it related to Buffer Law Compliance.

	The primary purpose of activities funded with Cover Crop Incentive Program funds is to assist with implementation of cover crops and promote the long-term adoption of cover crops in the farming operation.		
	The Red Lake County SWCD Board has established the maximum rate to a land occupier for installation of the cover crop practice is: \$15 for a single species Cover Crop ie. Cereal rye or oats, \$40 for a multiple species Cover Crop which means it must include one grass and one broad leaf species, or \$50 for a multiple species Cover Crop with reduced tillage; which is defined as including at least one grass and one broad leaf species, following an annual crop with a minimum of 50% residue left after seeding of the cover crop. These rates are a per acre payment.		
	The Red Lake County SWCD Board has established the maximum number of acres for a project applicant is 50 acres. The 50 acres may be subdivided into different tracts, but these tracts may not be smaller than 5 acres in size. The Red Lake County SWCD Board has established the minimum number of acres for a land occupier is 5 acres. The maximum number of contracts per land occupier is 5.
